Most recently, Adam has become one of the newest members within the United States Air Force Band’s Singing Sergeants in Washington, DC. He has performed for President Biden, served as a soloist at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, and was featured on the BBC as a soloist at the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo in Edinburgh, Scotland. Other accolades include being a 2021 semifinalist in the American Traditions Vocal Competition, as well as being a 2019 finalist for the Lotte Lenya Vocal Competition.

Some past favorite stage productions include *Buddy: The Buddy Holly Story* (Tuachan Center for the Arts), *Candide* (Pasadena Opera), *Show Boat* (Opera San Luis Obispo), *Grease* (Cabrillo Music Theater), the world premiere of *It’s Christmas Time!* (Tokyo Disneyland Resort), and *Merrily We Roll Along* (Wallis Annenberg for the Performing Arts) with Tony-winning director, Micheal Arden. On the concert stage, Adam was previously a member of the Los Angeles Master Chorale with the Los Angeles Philharmonic and has performed in many prestigious venues, such as the Walt Disney Concert Hall, Carnegie Hall, David Geffen Hall at Lincoln Center, and St. Patrick’s Cathedral. A native of Lima, Ohio, Adam graduated with a degree in vocal performance from Ohio Northern University and continued his graduate studies at the University of Kentucky.
